4. Get rid of unforgiveness.

b. You are complete in Him.

3. Radical intimacy with the Lord allows you to dwell

in the secret place instead of just visiting.

1. Consecrate daily time to be alone with God.

a. Draw near (close) to God and He will draw
near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners;
and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

b. But without faith it is impossible to please Him, Heb 11:6 for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.



2. Read the Bible.

a. Give ear to my words, O LORD, Consider my meditation. 2 Give heed to the voice of my cry, My King and my God, For to You I will pray. 3 My voice You shall hear in the morning, O LORD; In the morning I will direct [it] to You, And I will look up. Psalm 1:1-3; Josh 1:8 Psalm 5:1-3

3. Worship.

a. Begin with Thanksgiving and Praise.
