L. Multiply Your Turnaround

1. **Your Turnaround must be guarded, grown, and multiplied.**
2. **Guard What God Establishes.**
 - a. Your turnaround must be protected from attacks on your thoughts.
 - b. Vigilance, scripture, and boundaries protect what God establishes.
3. **Peace Is the Indicator of Sustained Victory**
 - a. Peace, as a spiritual Fruit, confirms godly delegated authority and power.
 - b. Trusting God frees you from anxiety, fear, and micromanagement, the need to control.
 - c. A calm, peaceful behavior and life is the mark of true spiritual maturity.
4. **Growth Is Required After Breakthrough**
 - a. Breakthrough is the doorway, not the finish line.
 - b. Obedience turns favor into forward momentum.
5. **What You Steward Well, God Multiplies**
 - a. God multiplies what is stewarded through gratitude, consistency, and honor.
6. **Turnarounds Are Meant to Bless Others**
 - a. Your restoration becomes a testimony that flows outward to bless others.
7. **Resist the Temptation to Return to Old Patterns**
 - a. Renewing your mind protects your turnaround and moves you forward.
8. **Authority Must Be Exercised Daily**
 - a. What you enforce daily remains established as you resist fear and defeat.
9. **From Personal Turnaround to Generational Impact**
 - a. God restores you to establish a legacy for your descendants.
10. **Living as a Keeper of What God Has Done**
 - a. Faithfully steward what God entrusted to you with wisdom and honor, preserving what favor began.
11. **Affirmation to Multiply Your Turnaround:**
In the Name of Jesus, I decree that what God has turned around in my life is guarded, growing, and multiplying. I walk in peace, steward my blessing well, and establish a legacy that honors God. What He has planted will remain, increase, and bless generations. Amen.

M. Build Your Turnaround Legacy

1. Make Your Turnaround a Generational Legacy Blessing

- a. A true turnaround becomes a generational blessing when it is protected, multiplied, and passed on.
- b. Ps 78:2-4 (AMPC): “2 I will open my mouth in a parable (in instruction by numerous examples); I will utter dark sayings of old [that hide important truth] 3 Which we have heard and known, and our fathers have told us. 4 We will not hide them from their children, but we will tell to the generation to come the praiseworthy deeds of the Lord, and His might, and the wonderful works that He has performed.”
- c. Prov 13:22 (AMPC): “22 A good man leaves an inheritance [of moral stability and goodness] to his children’s children, and the wealth of the sinner [finds its way eventually] into the hands of the righteous, for whom it was laid up.”
- d. Gen 12:2-3 (NKJV): “2 I will bless you...and you shall be a blessing.”

3 Legacy Is Built by What You Model, Not Just What You Decree

- a. Decrees shape your future; example shapes the next generation.
- b. How you steward victory teaches others how to live in it.
- c. Consistent faith and speaking the Word of God become transferable inheritance.

3. Generational Transfer Requires Intentional Stewardship

- a. What is not stewarded intentionally will not transfer successfully.
- b. Legacy is preserved by teaching others to speak, decree, steward, multiply and build it.
- c. Truth must be lived as an example, not just taught, to be passed on.

4. Dominion Must Be Possessed Before It Can Be Inherited

- a. You cannot pass down what you have not fully walked in.
- b. Dominion today secures spiritual territory for tomorrow’s generation.
- c. Your obedience today benefits future generations.

5. **The Blood Covenant of Jesus Christ Secures Your Godly Legacy**
 - a. Legacy is anchored in God's covenant promises.
 - b. What God establishes through The New Covenant cannot be uprooted.
 - c. Generational blessing flows from alignment with God and His Word, not perfect performance.
6. **God's Word Spoken Today Builds Tomorrow**
 - a. Decrees spoken now shape godly inheritance for future generations.
 - b. Praying and affirming the Word of God cultivates a spiritual lifestyle of glad expectation for every victory.
7. **Legacy Thinking Shapes Better Decisions and Priorities**
 - a. Stewardship becomes forward-focused, not self-centered.
 - b. Godly wisdom increases when God's Word guides your future for His Kingdom.
8. **Legacy Is Complete When Others Are Equipped to Steward It**
 - a. Legacy requires preparation of successors.
 - b. Teaching, modeling, and releasing responsibility ensures continuation.
 - c. Empowered next generations confirm successful legacy stewardship.
9. **Decree to Build My Godly Generational Legacy Turnaround (Say Once):**

In the Name of Jesus, I decree that my turnaround is establishing a godly generational legacy for my family line.
